 - Participants under the age of 18 must have parental consent for participation and media release.
 - Any participants over 18 may consent and register for themselves, but will be required to provide a verifiable ID (such as, drivers license, student ID, military ID, or passport).
 - All participants must submit a photo for the media release.
- There is no fee to participate; however, transportation to and from the program is the responsibility of the consenting adult or driving student.
- Participants are expected to actively participate in each day of the program and appear and perform in the **DayGLOW, Inc. - Southern Jam Night** event on Saturday, April 14, at *Grazing Here* in Peachtree City, GA. (Students should arrive by 7:30 p.m. with their performance concluding before 9 p.m.)
- Space is limited to the first 12 fully registered participant students.
